Eligibility Criteria

- To qualify for admission, applicants must meet one of the following criteria:
- **MPT holders** with at least 2 years of post-graduation experience.
- **BPT holders** with at least 5 years of post-graduation experience.
- Additionally, **two recommendation letters** from practicing physiotherapists are required.

Fellowship Duration

• Total Duration: 6 months (self-paced)

Includes time for research, independent study, and thesis submission.

• 35,000 INR

Admission Process

Application Submission: Complete the application form and submit required documents.

Research Topic Proposal: Submit five proposed research topics for review.
